

## Vintage Festival Rider Information

**Canadian Tire Motorsports Park** 3233 Concession Rd 10, Bowmanville, ON, L1C 3K6

- All spectator tickets are sold by VRRRA on-line and at the gate.
- 16 and under are admitted free as per CTMP policy
- Rider and crew (16 and over) tickets are sold at [www.vrra.ca](http://www.vrra.ca) and at registration.
- There is NO access to the facility prior to 6 pm, Thursday. There is no waiting in either the parking lot or on the road; you will be asked to leave and return at 6pm.

### Rider checklist

- I have an annual VRRRA membership
- I have registered for my races and practice
- I have completed the on-line VRRRA Waiver, and Concussion Code of Conduct
- I, and my crew, have completed the annual on-line insurance waiver and have a copy
- I, and my crew, have purchased gate tickets
- I have printed and completed one tech form for each machine
- If I am an Endurance Captain (team owner), I have filled out the Endurance Bike and Team Info Sheet and have a copy of the lap scoring sheet if I want to hand score my team

### Registration

- Registration will be open Thursday 6:00pm – 8:30pm, Friday 7:00am - 9:00am and 5:00pm – 7:00pm, Saturday 7:00am – 9:00am and 5:00pm – 6:00pm
- There is no registration on Sunday
- Registration is CLOSED during all rider's meetings.
- Registration will be located at the building immediately inside the front gate. The door facing the gate is for entry only, the opposite door is for exit.
- All registrants MUST present a paid gate ticket to register. No Exceptions!
- All entrants must bring completed tech sheets and endurance team info sheet to registration

### Accommodations

- There are camping facilities at the track with washrooms and showers. Please refer to the map in the CTMP event document indicating approved camping areas. Anyone camping outside of approved areas will be asked to move.
- Participants may stay over Sunday night, but must leave before 7:30am
- You may be asked to move to a different location Sunday evening

### Pit/Dirt Bikes

- No unlicensed motorized vehicles are allowed outside of the paddock area.

### Announcing

- Race Announcing should be on 90.7FM – we will confirm Friday.

### Rider's Meetings

- Are held each morning at 8:00am at the podium between the gas pumps and the restaurant.

### Trophies

- Trophy presentation is Sunday at the end of race weekend at the Podium between the gas pump and the restaurant.

### Souvenirs and Memberships

- T shirts, hats, posters, and other VRRRA souvenirs will be on sale by the large washroom in the upper paddock area.
- No cash – no problem, electronic payment is available.

### Technical Inspection

- Tech will be located near the large washroom in the upper paddock area.
- Tech Inspection will be closed during riders' meetings.
- Tech will open Thursday evening 6:30pm – dusk. Friday 7:00am – 9:00am and 6:00pm – 7:00pm. Saturday 7:00am – 8:00am. Sunday 7:00am – 8:00am.
- Thursday night and Friday morning are for bikes running Friday practice and Endurance only.
- During the event tech will be available. You will be informed of the location at the riders' meeting.
- Bring your completed tech sheets, stamped at registration, to Tech Inspection with your bike
- Helmets must be brought to tech if they have not been inspected at a VRRRA event this year.
- You must complete the helmet section of the tech form. You will be asked to show us the date of manufacture.

### VIP tech inspection

- VRRRA VIP bike tech is available at the Vintage Festival. We will tech your bike(s) in your pit, on your stands.
- Cost is \$20 for 1 bike, or \$35 for 2 or more bikes with same racing number. Cash only and the proceeds are a donation to VRRRA.
